Roebourne Placement Support Scholarship

OVERVIEW

The WACRH Roebourne Placement Support Scholarship provides financial assistance to allied health, nursing, and midwifery students completing clinical placements in Roebourne, Western Australia. Our goal is to improve rural, remote, and Aboriginal health through education, research, and community service activities.

GUIDELINES

- Clinical placements must be a minimum of four (4) weeks.
- Placements occur in Roebourne, Western Australia.
- Scholarship payments can only be used to assist with travel and/or accommodation expenses.
- Scholarship recipients are required to provide a 300-word placement experience statement and three placement photos, or a short video highlighting their rural experience.

ELIGIBILITY

- Currently studying full-time or part-time at an Australian university.
- Applicants who are recipients of any other scholarships or grants are not eligible for the Roebourne Placement Support Scholarship.

SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

- Award amount: \$400.00 to \$1,400.00 (based on placement type, duration, and funding availability).
- Covers travel and accommodation costs associated with the clinical placement.
